### About NYS Baroque

Now in our 36th season, **NYS Baroque** was founded in 1988 by oboist Peter Hedrick and bassoonist Elizabeth Hedrick, and has been directed since 2013 by lutenist Deborah Fox. We perform an annual concert series with world-class artists in both Syracuse and Ithaca. Our Young Artists program provides mentoring and concert opportunities to emerging musicians in our field of historical performance. NYS Baroque was awarded Early Music America's "Early Music Brings History Alive" award in 2006, for its Arts in Education collaborations with local teachers and students.

NYS Baroque performs music of the Renaissance, Baroque and early Classical periods on period instruments with what the *Syracuse Post-Standard* hails as "[an] exquisite balance of sound and astounding synchronicity".

### Meet the soloists

Mexican-American soprano **Andréa Walker** can be heard performing across the country with groups like GRAMMY® Award-winning orchestra Apollo's Fire, Atlanta Baroque Orchestra, Les Délices, and The Thirteen. She is thrilled to be making her debut with Pegasus Early Music, NYS Baroque, Seraphic Fire, and the Boston Early Music Festival in the 2024-2025 season. Ms. Walker is pursuing a Doctorate in historical performance practice at Case Western Reserve University. Prior to her time in Cleveland, she graduated with a Master's in vocal performance from the Yale Institute of Sacred Music where she specialized in early music, oratorio, and art song.

Praised for his “burnished tone and focused phrasing,” (Chestnut Hill Local) Haitian baritone **Jean Bernard Cerin** performs extensively with leading early music ensembles across the United States including Philadelphia based Publick Pleasure & Choral Arts, Louisville’s Bourbon Baroque, Classical Uncorked in Seattle, Les Délices in Cleveland, and American Bach Soloists in San Francisco to name a few. Recent highlights include Bach’s Peasant Cantata with soprano Julian Baird and the Philadelphia Bach Collegium and a staged performance of Bach’s Coffee Cantata with Classical Uncorked in Seattle Washington. On the operatic stage, Jean Bernard has portrayed villains, buffoons, and heroes with the Aspen Opera Theater Center, Brevard’s Janiec Opera Company, Center City Opera Theater in Philadelphia, and Opera Philadelphia, among others. Last season he made his company debut with Opera Lafayette in a modern premier of Jean-Joseph Mouret’s *Les Fêtes de Thalie* at the Kennedy Center. Jean Bernard Cerin is the artistic director of the Lisette Project, a performance and research collective focusing on the history of classical music in Haiti. He serves as an assistant professor and director of the Voice Program at Cornell University in Ithaca New York.
